

**PROPOSED LANDSCAPE DEVELOPMENT IN  
BUKIT CINA, MELAKA**

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## **ABSTRAK**

Warisan bandar menyaksikan pembangunan satu bandar. Isu-isu warisan bandar telah dibangkitkan di mana nilai tanah dalam kawasan bandar ialah satu komponen penting untuk pembangunan. Bagaimanapun, kerajaan mengiktiraf sumbangan warisan kebudayaan sebagai peningkatan kesejahteraan sosial hidup dan aset penting negara. Pemulihan warisan bandar akan memberi satu imej baru dan melanjutkan fungsi asal tapak sendiri. Sementara itu, pemulihan warisan bandar juga boleh menggariskan sumbangan luas dalam pembangunan lestari. Melalui kajian-kajian rujukan Singapore Fort Canning dan Kuala Lumpur Kwong Tong Cemetery dan Glasgow Necropolis, laporan ini akan menilaikan kelemahan-kelemahan pemulihan warisan bandar dan mencadangkan cara-cara untuk mengatasi permasalahan ini melalui fahaman yang lebih mendalam sebagaimana interaksi manusia dengan persekitaran bandar dan warisannya. Laporan ini menjelaskan pedekatan pemuliharaan yang digunakan dalam cadangan pembangunan lanskap di Bukit Cina sebagai satu usaha dalam melindungi warisan bandar yang memberikan erti yang bermakna untuk kaum Cina di Malaysia.

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Urban heritage witness the growth of a city. The issues of urban heritage have been raise as the land in urban area is an important component for development. However, increasingly the government recognizes the contribution that built cultural heritage makes to the social well-being of different groups living and the important asset of the country. Rehabilitation of urban heritage would give a new image and extend the original function of the site itself. Meanwhile, the rehabilitation of urban heritage also could outline the broad contribution in sustainable development. Through the reference studies of Singapore Fort Canning and Kuala Lumpur Kwong Tong Cemetery and Glasgow Necropolis, the report could concludes a brief discussion of shortcomings of urban heritage rehabilitation and suggests how these might be overcome through a greater understanding of how people interact with the urban environment and its heritage. The output of the report illustrate the conservation approach use in the proposed landscape development in Bukit Cina as an effort in protecting the urban heritage which gives significant meaning to the Malaysian Chinese.
